WATER METERS

DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME

Spring forward your clocks and don't forget to replace the batteries in your smoke alarms at the same time.

On Sunday, March 10, 2013 @ 2 a.m., time is advanced one hour to start daylight savings time. Fire services all over N. America suggest to the public to use this occasion to remember to change their smoke alarm batteries. The average life of a smoke alarm battery is one year. Smoke alarms that are more than 10 years old should also be replaced as they may not operate properly, despite having a new battery or working electrical connection.
