VILLAGE NEWS

It is our hope that this finds you all well and healthy. This has certainly been an interesting, if not challenging , past several weeks. We thank everyone for their adherence to social distancing and following the provincial mandates. As the weather turns warmer and there is an inkling to relax a bit, please remember that social distancing and groups of 15 or smaller are still mandated.

Hill Spring Council recently made a motion, subject to grant approval, to proceed with an aggregate solar energy system. They are working with Solar Seekers Inc.

Mountain View Industries, out of Cardston, is constructing a new building which will house the new Hill Spring Post Office. We are planning for it to be in place by June 30, 2020.

A land tax sale for property East 1/2 of Lot 1, Block 13 , Plan 370 BD will be sold at a public auction, June 29, 2020, 10:00 a.m. at the Hill Spring Community Hall. The following conditions apply: \$30,000.00 minimum bid, successful bidder must pay for purchase day of sale by certified cheque or bank draft, present building must be removed from property within 45 days of title transfer.

The Village is working with Tough Country to bring faster internet in to the Village. Stay tuned for future information.

In the next 2-3 weeks there will be a few sections of sidewalk replaced from the corner of 1 ave S & 1 St W to center ave and also along 1st ave S from corner of 1 St W to 2 St W.

The UID is hoping to turn the water into the canal within the next 1 1/2 weeks. If all goes as planned the irrigation will be turned on in the Village before the end of May.

If you need a local or Regional Business License you can purchase them at the Village office.

If you own a dog or dogs this is a reminder to be a responsible pet owner. Please keep your dogs at home on your property , leashed when off property and scoop their poop to properly dispose of it. For those of you who have not paid for your annual dog license, please stop by the office and take care of it.

Cemetery clean up day is scheduled for Saturday, June 13, 2020, 9:00 a.m. —12:00 noon. Lunch will be served at 11:30. Please bring rakes, hoes, weed whippers, pruning shears, shovels etc.

If you have trees hanging over sidewalks, or bushes encroaching onto the sidewalks please have them trimmed back. If you are interested in the Village hiring someone to do this work and you pay for it then contact the office.
