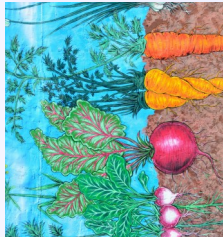

VILLAGE WORK: Beck's Excavating finished the sewer line upgrade along Hiway 800 between 1st and 2nd avenue south. The Village appreciates the patience of the residents and inconvenience while this project was underway.

The Village will begin the first phase of a water looping project along 2nd street west and between 1st and 3rd avenue. This project is estimated to begin in about 4 weeks with completion slated for mid October 2020.

The Village recently had a solar system installed on the east end of the village. Solar Seekers completed that project July 31 and it was inspected and passed Aug. 5. This addition to the Village will positively cut the cost of the Village power bills.

Tough Country Communications will be installing a VMAX system in the village. Tough Country is a local internet service provider that provides wireless internet to individuals and businesses in Southern Alberta. At no charge to the Village they will be connecting their wireless system to the Axia Supernet. If you are interested in signing up for their service you can call them at 403-627-4126. They will be providing free internet service to the Village Office and to the Community Hall.

COMMUNITY HALL: The Village Council motioned to open up the Community Hall for private events but all COVID health and government regulations must be met and will be strictly enforced. The group limit is 50 and a cleaning fee must be paid on top of the regular rental fee and damage deposit.

TAX INFORMATION: Please note that the taxes were due July 31, 2020. Thank you to all who have been diligent in getting their taxes paid. Any taxes that remained unpaid after the due and payable date received a 12% penalty on Aug. 1, 2020. A 1.5 % penalty will be imposed on the total unpaid balance of the tax accounts and applied the 1st day of each calendar month. Such penalties will become part of taxes owing. This penalty does not apply to the tax levy amounts being paid under the Tax Installment Program.. Taxes are a debt owed to the Village. Any property on which the taxes are in arrears are liable to the recovery process as outlined in the Municipal Government Act. You can sign up for automatic monthly withdrawal so that you are not stuck with a big invoice to pay all at once. If you are interested you can contact the village office for more information.

BOULEVARDS: I remind you that unless it is a designated driveway you are not allowed to park or place things on the boulevard.

Creamy Raspberry Dessert

- Graham cracker crumb crust
- **FILLING**
- 1 package (10 oz.) frozen raspberries, thawed 1/4 cup cold water
- 1 envelope unflavored gelatin 1 pkg (8 oz.) cream cheese, softened
- 1/2 cup sugar 1 cup heavy whipping cream, whipped

Drain raspberries, reserving the juice. Set berries aside. In a small saucepan, combine juice, water and gelatin. Let stand for 5 minutes, then heat and stir until gelatin is dissolved. Remove from heat and cool 10 minutes. In small bowl, beat cream cheese and sugar until smooth. Add berries and gelatin mixture. Beat on low until thoroughly blended. Chill until partially set. Gently fold in whipped cream. Spoon into crust and chill for 6 hours or overnight. Top with fresh berries and mint if desired. Enjoy!
