## VILLAGE NEWS

Utility Bills have been mailed out. They are due on or before Dec. 2, 2020. Please note that according to Utility Bylaw 2018-294 if your utilities are in arrears in excess of 4 months you will receive a water shutoff notice. Please pay your Village utilities to avoid that happening to you.

There are still several outstanding taxes. If your taxes are delinquent please make arrangements to make that payment and avoid being registered in tax arrears with the province. Taxes are a debt owed to the Village. Thanks to those who are current.

Village Council has been working on the 2021 operating and capital budget so they are ready to roll with it beginning January 2021.

The Village is looking for volunteers to serve on the cemetery committee. If you are willing please call or visit the office.

Hill Spring is happy to announce that the new building housing the post office is now in operation. Thank you all for your patience during this transitional period. Many of you have wondered what is happening with the old building. No final decisions have been made concerning its outcome.
