

In accordance with the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26, the Village of Hill Spring will prepare a tax arrears list of all parcels of land which have been in arrears for more than one year. (i.e.—2019, 2020) This list will be sent to the Government of Alberta registrar and posted in the Village office. The Registrar will endorse the certificate of title with a tax recovery notification, which acts as a lien against the listed property until the taxes are paid in full. Should taxes remain unpaid, the property will then be listed for sale by public auction within one year of notification. Taxes are a debt owed to the Village and must be paid. We would appreciate your attention to this matter so that we may avoid any further action.

Village Council recently passed the Fees Rates and Charges Bylaw 2021-245. You will notice a slight increase in your Village Utilities. This and all current bylaws may be viewed on the Hill Spring website.

There will be a public hearing for Proposed Bylaw 2021-230 Municipal Development Plan, Tuesday March 16, 2021 @ 7:00 p.m. at Hill Spring Council Chambers. The bylaw is available to read in the Village office or on the village website.

The skating rink is now closed for the season. It has been a well used facility this year. Thank you to those volunteers who worked to keep it functioning and operable.
