Utility Bills have been mailed out. They are due on or before Dec. 1, 2021. Please note that according to Utility Bylaw 2018-294 if your utilities are in arrears in excess of 4 months (2 billings) you will receive a water shut-off notice. Please pay your Village utilities to avoid that happening to you.

There are still several outstanding taxes. If your taxes are delinquent please make arrangements to make that payment and avoid being registered in tax arrears with the province. Taxes are a debt owed to the Village. Thanks to those who are current.

If you have made a payment to the Village office on utilities or taxes in September/October and it is not reflected on your invoice please contact admin at the village office. There has been a direct deposit made but no reference of where it is from. If it is you please provide office with proof of payment information.

The Village is looking for volunteers to serve on the cemetery committee. If you are willing please call or visit the office.
