

About the Position

The Municipality of Hill Spring has an immediate opening for a Seasonal Labourer (May until September). The Seasonal Labourer is responsible for making sure the community spaces look great. We are looking for individuals who are organized, energetic, reliable, and willing to roll up their sleeves and get to work. This position reports to the Chief Administrative Officer or designate and will be expected to work flexible hours.

Responsibilities/ Accountabilities:

Specific duties include:

- Landscaping, Parks, Cemetery Maintenance Operate power and hand tools to complete repairs and preventative maintenance tasks; groom park green areas and municipal grounds; cut grass with riding mowers, weed control; trash hauling, paint structures; support tree care and drainage work.
- Planting, watering, and weeding.
- Irrigation repair and monitoring
- Culvert cleaning
- Window washing
- Restroom cleaning.
- Other duties as assigned.

Experience/Skills/Education:

The successful applicant must meet the following criteria:

- Hold a High School Diploma or equivalency (e.g. G.E.D).
- Class 5 Driver's License
- Must be physically capable of performing manual labour in various weather conditions.
- Ability to work in a team and independently.

Notes:

- Preference may be given to individuals with groundskeeping experience.
- 32 Hours per week (weather dependent).
