

VILLAGE OF HILL SPRING

BYLAW NUMBER 2009-290

A BYLAW of the Village of Hill Spring, in the Province of Alberta, to rescind old tax by-laws.

WHEREAS section 63 of the Municipal Government Act being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000, as amended, provides that:

63(1) A council may by bylaw authorize the revision of all or any of the bylaws of the municipality.

(2)

(b) omitting and providing for the repeal of a bylaw or a provision of a bylaw that is inoperative, obsolete, expired, spent or otherwise ineffective;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to remove obsolete by-laws from the books.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Hill Spring, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. This by-law may be cited as "Red Book Rescinding By-law".

This by-law repeals the by-laws from bylaw 61-1 up to bylaw 91-211 inclusive, with the exception of bylaw 90-208.

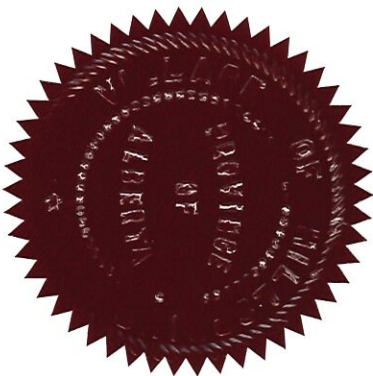
Effective Dates

2. This by-law shall come into effect on the date of final reading thereof.

Read a second time in Council this 15<sup>th</sup> day of December A.D., 2009.

Upon unanimous consent of Council Present, read a third time and finally passed this 15<sup>th</sup> day of December A.D., 2009
