VILLAGE OF HILL SPRING

BYLAW # 2021 - 321 ASSESSOR BYLAW

A Bylaw of the Village of Hill Spring, in the Province of Alberta, for the purpose to appoint an assessor as a designated officer in the Village of Hill Spring and assigning the duties of the position.

WHEREAS Pursuant to Section 210 of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26, R.S.A. 2000, as amended, describes the appointment of Designated Officers;

AND WHEREAS Section 284 of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26, R.S.A. 2000, requires that an Assessor be appointed as a Designated Office;

Now THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Village of Hill Spring duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

This Bylaw shall be cited as the "Assessor Bylaw".

1. Definitions

In this Bylaw these definitions prevail:

- 1.1. "Assessor" shall mean a person, body corporate or commission, appointed by a municipality to the position of Assessor as defined in Section 284(d) of the Municipal Government Act;
- 1.2. "Council" shall mean the Council of The Village of Hill Spring;
- 1.3. **"Designated Officer"** shall mean a Designated Officer within the meaning of the Municipal Government Act.

2. Establishment

The following Designated Officer position is established:

- 2.1. Assessor: to carry out the powers, duties and responsibilities of an assessor as required by the Municipal Government Act; and
- 2.2. The assessor shall be appointed by a resolution of Council.

3. Date of Commencement

3.1. This bylaw shall come into effect upon passing of third and final reading.
